Eligibility:

The applicant must be a member of St. George Antiochian Orthodox Church of Cedar Rapids, Iowa. This means that he or she was baptized or chrismated in the Orthodox church; participates in the sacraments of the Orthodox church; **that St. George is considered the applicant's home parish, and that he or she has been an active member of St. George during their K-12 years, not all inclusive.**

Individual Service Project

Show your continued devotion and commitment to St. George Church by designing a service project to be completed as a part of the application process. You must hand deliver your project proposal and your scholarship application form to the parish priest no later than October 1st. Your project proposal must include a brief description of your service project, and all proposed projects are pending the scholarship committee's approval. Be creative and feel free to enlist the help of your church family and friends to complete your service project, but remember this is your service project and you must be active and lead in every aspect of this project to see it to completion.

Ideas for service projects include but are not limited to:

- Planning and completing a church clean-up day
- Helping to teach a Sunday school class for a number of weeks
- Helping to coordinate and direct the annual Christmas play
- Planning and completing a project to update the choir books (Coordinate efforts with the choir director)

These are but a few ideas and the committee members, including the parish priest, are here to assist you in coming up with appropriate, feasible projects.
